MushiKing, The King of Beetles, Dinosaur King and Love & Berry will be the first products that this team will handle. These unique games feature collectible trading cards that have taken the Japanese market by storm. We look forward to bringing that success here to our market. Watch for our exciting launch coming soon!

In closing, I would like to stop and acknowledge what Sega means to this industry and to me personally. We are here to deliver you exceptional product, customer service and innovations. Take a look around at what we have to offer. Look at us now at the end of the merger year, and also think what Sega promises for the future.
